Vehicle Movement– risk of collision (people vs vehicle)	M	Drivers are given access to private parking spaces. Member of Forest of Hearts team will monitor car park as attendees arrive.
		Drivers to keep speed slow whilst driving on small lane.
		Ensure equipment isn't left on the tarmac lane and attendees to stay vigilant of any cars when in that area.
Slippery Surfaces (Usually due to weather conditions)	М	Ensure good housekeeping. Arrange an alternative bypass route.
,		Advise participants to wear appropriate footwear.
Uneven Surfaces or loose paving slabs.	М	Ensure good housekeeping. Slabbed area will be thoroughly assessed beforehand.
		Member of Forest of Hearts team will ensure attendees are aware of any when welcoming attendees at the entrance. Barriers erected to restrict entry.

Trips, Falls.	М	Keep pathways clear at all times, including those in outside and indoor working areas.
		Make attendees aware of uneven ground on the field.
		Avoid leaving tools around the area when not in use and tidy up frequently between activities.
Using Tools (Spades, Trowels).	М	Tool maintenance and safety checks made when setting up equipment.
		Ensure use of suitable PPE – Gloves, to prevent cuts and provide adequate grip.
		First aid kit on site.
Moving heavy equipment/trees	М	Apply safe manual handling work practices.

		Attendees to only move things if physically fit and able to.
		Ensure attendees carry heavy trees in pairs and not alone.
Planting trees - tree branches and sharp-edged bamboo planting canes	М	Briefing at start of activity to make attendees aware of appropriate methods to plant trees and use equipment.
		Take care and attention when planting trees to ensure sharp tree branches and bamboo canes don't come in contact with the face.
