- Encourage virtual participation by supplying live streamed presentations and handouts and
 use augmented reality to support learning in order to minimise unnecessary use of paper.
 Use technology and video-conferencing in order to increase access to those who wish to
 attend but not to travel.
- Minimise energy use and use of raw materials to minimise waste and recycle all plastics, aluminium, paper, card, glass etc.
- Encourage a "No give-ways give it away" policy by avoiding give-aways that just get thrown away and donating the money that would have been spent to charity
- **Set objectives and targets** to drive continual improvement programmes and review our environmental performance annually to ensure success.
- Ensure that all staff and associates are aware of this policy and trained in their environmental responsibilities.
- Make this policy available to our customers and the public on our website.
